

TRAVIS GALE ROOKIE ON A RIDE

How does a training schedule of 8km per day, the wrong gear and an out of sync weather plan, get two men across 4 continents on a bicycle, to raise R1.7 million for children living with HIV / AIDS in KZN, South Africa?

Travis Gale, one of the two cyclists, shares of a journey which began long before they peddled onto the streets of Johannesburg on the 1st January 1999 for the year long tour.

This account is woven around two ordinary men who found out what it meant to turn an **idea into reality. Pushing through negativity, leaving everything they knew and the daily grind on the peddles set them up to experience the worlds people and places in way they could have never imagined possible.**

Given this experience marked the birth of the 'life as an Appletree' metaphor, Travis uses media, images and story to share about a journey which still continues today.
